

## Fact Sheet E-Scooters

### Traffic rules for Slovenia

#### Age

- Persons older than 14 years or from 12 to 14 years old, if they have a cycling licence.

#### Cycling infrastructure

- Permitted on areas intended for cyclists. Where there are no such surfaces, permitted along the right edge of the urban road, where the maximum permitted speed is up to 50 kilometers per hour. The rules that apply to cyclists also apply to drivers of e-scooters or light motor vehicles.
- Forbidden on pavements
- Pedestrian zones: forbidden unless bicycles are allowed (but only at walking speed)

#### Speed limit

- 25 km/h

#### Equipment

- No seat device
- Handlebar
- Running board
- At least 1 brake device
- Reflectors and reflective foils (white to the front, red to the back and yellow or orange side reflectors on both sides)
- At night and in poor visibility: white front light, red rear light

#### Parking rules

- On designated areas for rental E-scooters
- For other E-scooters the same rules apply as to bicycles: in bicycle parking areas and in such way that they cannot fall or obstruct traffic

#### Helmet

- For children under 18 years

#### Alcohol and drugs

- Blood alcohol level: max. 0.5 ‰ or 0.24 milligrams of alcohol per liter of exhaled air
- No drugs

#### Miscellaneous

- One rider only
- No driving licence required (maximum speed of 25 km/h)
- Usage of headphones or mobile phones forbidden while riding
- No licence plates or compulsory insurance required
